To the Kind Attn. of the EHA GA members

Dear Colleagues,

End of April/beginning of May we will have our next BG/GA virtual meeting.

On our last meeting in November 2020, we agreed to shift the elections for the new BG and EB to the next meeting because we were still in a phase to dissolve the NHAC. Meanwhile the drafting of the revised AoA of EHA are in a final stage with our German lawyers and we hope to be able to present them to you before the next BG/GA meeting.

Concerning the elections, I would like to inform you, that I would not run for a second mandate as Chairman of EHA. As you all know, I retired from my position as Crew Training Manager at Luxembourg Air Rescue on January 1st 2021, at the age of 65. Some of you might say, that is fine, now you are full time available for EHA. Well, on one hand I would like to but on the other hand I do have to accept the hard fact that my remaining life time is limited and I do have some obligations with regard to my family, which I neglected during the past 40 years.

Based on my experience gained as Chairman during the past 2.5 years I strongly recommend **not** continuing with a “part time” chairperson.

The association and the political and financial environment of the EHA have changed dramatically. The engagement on the European political level needs to be strongly improved. In light of EUROPEAN ROTORS, the structure of EHA needs to be adapted to include a commercial entity. Most likely, the setup of this entity will be initiated before the end of my office as Chairman.

The group of our technical experts needs to be better staffed and financially supported to be able to work on the interests of our members more effectively. This will require a full time chairperson with profound management and economic skills to guide the association to the next level of performance for the benefit of our members.

It will be a pleasure for me to support the association and the interests of our members in the future on a more technical level, be it as representative in the various committees, working groups or RMGs or in further developing EUROPEAN ROTORS.

A small but outstanding team will support the new chairperson strongly: Isabella, who took over extremely fast and well the responsibilities and tasks of the Executive Director and by Anna, who performs all the administrative tasks perfectly to keep the association and all its activities running.

In order to prepare the election of the new chairperson for the next BG/GA meeting I kindly ask to send in your proposals for candidates or your individual candidacies until March 31st 2021. In parallel, we will open straight away the position for external candidates in LinkedIn and on the EHA homepage. A review of the applications and a possible selection of candidates would be done by the EB/BG beginning of April.

I want to close this letter by thanking all of you for your trust and support during the past 2.5 years, which have not been easy, starting with the legal dispute we had with Reed, Elisabetta's resignation as ED, the start-up of EUROPEAN ROTORS and finally the COVID-19 pandemic causing the first edition of EUROPEAN ROTORS to be postponed.

It has been and it still is a great honour for me to serve the European Helicopter Association as Chairman in these challenging times. However, to be honest, I also look forward to some easier and relaxing times to come.
